**NASA's Day of Remembrance**

NASA, in partnership with the Astronauts Memorial Foundation and Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex, will host NASA's Day of Remembrance on Thursday, January 26. The ceremony will take place at the Space Mirror Memorial in the visitor complex and will honor all astronauts who have sacrificed their lives while furthering the cause of space exploration and discovery. This year's Day of Remembrance also marks 20 years since the Columbia tragedy.

Scheduled to speak at the ceremony are Thad Altman, president and CEO of the Astronauts Memorial Foundation and Janet Petro, center director, NASA Kennedy Space Center. The commemoration will include a wreath laying ceremony and attendees will be given flowers to pay respects to our fallen heroes.

The ceremony will be streamed live on Kennedy Space Center's Facebook page at 10 a.m. ET on Thursday, January 26.

In addition, we welcome all guests to visit Forever Remembered, a memorial for the crews of Columbia and Challenger inside Space Shuttle Atlantis® and Ad Astra Per Aspera for the astronauts of Apollo 1 at the Apollo/Saturn V Center. Each memorial includes displays of the astronauts' personal items and recovered hardware as a tribute to these heroes. As always, these memorials are included with daily admission to the visitor complex.

**Space Mirror Memorial**

NASA's fallen heroes are honored at this monument to commemorate astronauts who gave their lives in pursuit of knowledge that lies beyond Earth. Highly polished black granite is emblazoned with the names of 24 astronauts, including the crews of Apollo 1, STS-51L Challenger and STS-107 Columbia. Dedicated in 1991 and created by the Astronauts Memorial Foundation the Space Mirror Memorial is designated as a national memorial on the National Register of Historic Places. Constantly illuminated, the astronaut names on this memorial are a simple reminder that space exploration can require the ultimate sacrifice.

**Hogue's IGA Celebrates 62 Years**

Hogue's IGA celebrated 62 years of service to the Bellevue community on January 17th, with a ribbon cutting ceremony. It was a perfect opportunity to show off the many improvements and upgrades made to the store over the past few years.

Hogue's is a full-service grocery store, with all the usual food items, hand cut meats, and fresh vegetables and fruit. In addition, they offer a large tobacco sales area, a nice selection of wines, and an Ohio Liquor store.

Owner Dwight Hogue opened the IGA with his parents 62 years ago. Said Hogue, "I was born into the grocery business. My dad was a meat cutter. He taught me how to do that. We had a little corner store in Shelby, as every little town had, and we lived in the

apartment over it."

After he married the store just couldn't support two families, so he talked with his dad about finding a location to open up a second store. They originally planned to build in Shelby, but another store beat them to it. With two stores already in Shelby, the Hogue's decided to look elsewhere. They chose this site because they thought it was a good site close to a growing population and there were no other grocery stores close.

The 62 years have seen a lot of changes; not only in the grocery business, but in the physical nature of the store itself. All the product cases have been changed out: the freezer, deli, beer and the produce case.
